How do I sign up for Concurrent Enrollment (CE)?

Need to apply to DSU *every year*,

Confirm your registration with your teacher

I passed my AP test now what?

Bring your scores to your counselor *and* registrar's office at the College/University of your choice. Scores are not automatically placed on your transcripts.

How do I get a copy of my ACT Score?

Yes, but please make sure you've created an account prior to requesting.

Do you send my ACT scores to NCAA?

You're ACT scores are listed on your transcript, however NCAA requires they be sent directly from ACT. ***They will not accept them from your High School.***
